I.K.E.J.A AGENDA: Making Governance Work for All is a blueprint that enunciates policies and strategies for bold interventions categorised into 5 program areas.
















nvestment in maintenance of public infrastructure and enhancement of liveable environment will be accorded priority through the following programs:

Road Rehabilitation: Upgrade of inner roads across communities to ease traffic flow and improve accessibility.

Flood Control: Construction of new drainage systems and desilting of existing drainages to mitigate flooding.

Community-based Participation: Initiate local monitoring of project implementation by stakeholders for quality, sustainability and maintenance of public assets

Public-Private Partnerships (PPP): Collaboration with the private sector and development agencies to improve infrastructure and promote maintenance culture.



To drive entrepreneurship and socio-economic emancipation for sustainable incomes, we are committed to:

- Establishment of ICT hubs for training in Data Science, Al, Software Engineering and Multimedia.
- Establishment of ICT labs in schools to promote digital literacy to encourage innovation among students.
- Provision of facilities for career enhancement, especially for women and youths.
- Promotion of entrepreneurship skills with targeted empowerment programs designed for youth, women, and Persons with Disabilities (PWDs).
- Provision of bursaries and facilities to students, particularly those who are indigent.

- Improve school administration within the Local Government Education Authority (LGEA).
- Upgrade of school infrastructure to provide world-class learning environment.
- Provision of adequate staffing and teaching resources.
- Provision of functional toilet facilities in schools to improve hygiene.
- Training and retraining of teachers and administrators for effective instructional delivery and school leadership.
- Establishment of reward system for outstanding educators.
- Establishment of state-of-the-art secondary school in Ikeja LGA.
- Creation of opportunities for the acquisition of entrepreneurship of skills





ENVIRONMENTAL GOVERNANCE AND HEALTHCARE INITIATIVES

Community well-being and safety will be enhanced through the following interventions:

Lighting and Security: Install solar streetlights in underserved areas; with priority attention high-traffic and nightlife zones. Partner with community groups for comprehensive security assessments.

Waste Management and Recycling: Launch the "Ikeja Green Economy Initiative" in partnership with LAWMA and corporate bodies to promote recycling, emission reduction, and enforcement of environmental laws. A recycling program will also be implemented in all local government facilities.

Market Upgrades: Upgrade market infrastructure to ensure safety and hygiene,



particularly in the food sector.

Environmental Protection Initiatives:

- Effective monitoring of waste disposal through shared responsibility with stakeholders in the neighbourhoods
- Provision of mobile toilet facilities to curb open defecation and poor hygiene
- Provision of facilities to enhance Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) practices in schools and public places.







HEALTHCARE INITIATIVES

The following initiatives will be prioritised to enhance access to health facilities and treatments:

- Renovation and equipping of existing Primary Health Centres (PHCs) to deliver quality services.
- Establishing new PHCs in underserved communities.
- Ensuring all PHCs are accessible to persons with disabilities and include maternal care facilities.
- Recruiting and retaining qualified healthcare professionals in partnership with the Lagos State Health Management Board and Ministry of Health.
- Establish Emergency Desk to facilitate telemedicine and home care services.
- Improve access to maternal and infant healthcare.





Telemedicine Desk Service

- Mobilising corporate participation through CSR to enhance quality of primary healthcare (PHC) delivery system.
- Facilitating quarterly free medical outreach to enhance preventive care.
- Provision of free eye tests and glasses under the JIGL AKOD initiative.

- Subsidized food banks in collaboration with corporate bodies to ensure affordable access to nutritious food.

The following will be implemented to ensure public safety and promote social order:

- Establishment of Ikeja Security Forum, involving community associations, businesses, and security agencies to coordinate intelligence and pro-active responses.
- Community surveillance with the use of technological devices in partnership with public and private crime prevention agencies.

Sports Development:

Development of sports facilities and engagement of youths in sports activities will be critical pillar of our commitment to building a just society. Sports activities will supported in schools and across the neighborhoods as a vehicle for unity and talent discovery.

Sports development initiatives aimed at Keeping our youth engaged and build a strong sense of community identity include:

- Establishment of the Ikeja Sports
 Council: A dedicated council to plan,
 organize, and oversee sporting activities
 across schools, wards, and communities in
 Ikeja.
- Annual Ikeja Inter-School Sports
 A platform to promote healthy competition rivalry and discover budding talents among students across public and private schools.
- The Ikeja Games: A community-driven sports festival designed to foster grassroots participation and inclusivity across the wards.
- Ikeja City Marathon: An annual city-wide event to be held in partnership with private organizations, to promote fitness, tourism, and brand visibility for Ikeja.
- Support for School Sports (Inter-House Sports): Provision of funding support for the revival and sustenance of inter-house sports competitions in public schools.

Culture and Traditions

Ikeja is home to a rich blend of indigenous communities with deep-rooted cultural heritage. We are committed to preserving, promoting and institutionalising the culture and traditions of our people as a vital part of community development and identity.

Our cultural development agenda will include:

 Support for Isese Day (August 20): The annual Isese Day celebration will be accorded recognition and provided logistical support from the local government to ensure a vibrant, inclusive, and dignified observance.

- Establishment of the Ikeja Culture & Tradition Advisory Board: A formal board comprising traditional rulers, community elders, cultural custodians, and stakeholders will be constituted to formulate policies and provide guidance on cultural affairs in Ikeja.
- Support for Egungun Festivals Across Ikeja: The revered Egungun festivals held in various communities will be supported by the government to enhance their visibility, organization, and cultural significance.



 Promotion of Indigenous Arts, Language, and Customs: Cultural programs will be introduced in schools and community centers to promote Yoruba language, history, arts, and customs among the youngergeneration.



Through these initiatives, we aim to protect our heritage, give voice to our traditions, and promote a united lkeja community rooted in pride and cultural awareness.






ACCOUNTABILITY AND GOOD GOVERNANCE
